#### ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

### CHICO COMMUNITY SCHOLARSHIP ASSOCIATION

I

The name of this corporation shall be CHICO COMMUNITY SCHOLARSHIP ASSOCIATION.

II

The purposes for which this corporation is formed are:

- (a) The specific and primary purposes are to receive, acquire, hold, manage, administer and expend property and funds for charitable and electrosynary purposes; to encourage and sponsor the awarding of scholarships to students and to coordinate the scholarship activities of persons, firms and organizations in the Chico Unified and the Durham Unified School Districts, Butte County, California.
- (b) The general purposes and powers are to do all acts necessary or expedient for the administration of the affairs and attainment of the specific and primary purposes for which this corporation is formed. This corporation shall possess all of the rights and powers granted to non-profit corporations by the laws of the State of California.
- (c) Notwithstanding any statement of purposes or powers sforesaid, this corporation shall not, except to an insubstantial degree, engage in any activities or exercise any powers that are not in furtherance of its specific and primary purposes.

The authorized number and qualifications of members of the corporation, the different classes of membership, if any, the property, voting and other rights and privileges of members, and their liability to dues and assessments and the method of collection thereof, shall be as set forth in the Bylaws. The property of this corporation is irrevocably dedicated to charitable purposes and no part of the net income or assets of this organization shall ever inure to the benefit of any private persons. Upon the dissolution or winding up of the corporation, its assets, remaining after payment, or provision for payment, of all debts and liabilities of this corporation, shall be distributed to a nonprofit fund, foundation, or corporation which is organized and operated exclusively for charitable purposes and which has established its tax exempt status under Sections 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

If this corporation holds any assets in trust, or the corporation is formed for charitable purposes, such assets shall be disposed of in such manner as may be directed by decree of the superior court of the county in which the corporation has its principal office, upon petition therefor by the Attorney General or by any person concerned in the liquidation, in a proceeding to which the Attorney General is a party.

#### VIII

No substantial part of the activities of this corporation shall consist of carrying on propagands, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate or intervene in any political campaign (including the publishing or distribution of statements) on behalf of any candidate for public office.
